Description and Purpose of Data Processing

The Faculty announces a photo contest titled
“Student Life at DE FAFSEM – Through My Lens.”

Eligible applicants: Current Hungarian and international students of the Faculty.

Submitted photos:

Photos taken by the applicant depicting student life and **not containing identifiable faces**.

Exhibition

Selected entries will be displayed in the glass corridor of Building B at the Faculty of Agricultural and Food Sciences and Environmental Management, University of Debrecen, from **15 May 2026**.

Evaluation of Entries

Submitted photos will be evaluated by a judging committee, and the best entries will be selected for exhibition. A **Public Choice Award** will be granted to the applicant whose photo receives the highest number of votes. Online voting will be conducted via the Faculty's official Facebook page: <https://www.facebook.com/DEMEK.fb>

Data Processing Activities

1. Submission of Entries

Personal data processed:

Name, programme, year of study, title of the photo, location where the photo was taken

Legal basis:

Consent of the data subject pursuant to Article 6(1)(a) GDPR
(in the case of minors, consent of the legal representative)

Purpose:

Administration and management of the photo contest

Duration:

From submission until withdrawal of consent or archiving

2. Publication on the Faculty's Social Media Platform (Facebook)

Personal data processed:

Name of the applicant and the submitted photo

Legal basis:

Consent of the data subject pursuant to Article 6(1)(a) GDPR
(in the case of minors, consent of the legal representative)

Purpose:

Conducting public voting and selecting winning entries

Duration:

From submission until withdrawal of consent or archiving

3. Image Recording and Publication (Award Ceremony)

Personal data processed:

Photographs taken at the award ceremony, name of the winner, and the winning entry

Legal basis:

Consent of the data subject pursuant to Article 6(1)(a) GDPR
(in the case of minors, consent of the legal representative)

Purpose:

Informing the public about the results of the contest and promoting the event

Duration:

Until withdrawal of consent

Persons with Access to the Data

Data may be accessed by staff members of the Faculty involved in organizing, administering, and evaluating the contest, as well as representatives of the Faculty's Student Union (HÖK), all of whom are bound by confidentiality obligations.

Rights of Data Subjects and Rules for Exercising Them

Right to Information

Pursuant to Article 15(1) GDPR, the data subject has the right to request information about the personal data processed by the Data Controller.

Right to Access / Copy

Under Article 15(3)–(4) GDPR, the data subject may request a copy of their personal data.

Right to Rectification

Under Article 16 GDPR, the data subject may request correction or completion of their personal data.

Right to Restriction of Processing

The data subject may request restriction of processing in the following cases:

- if they contest the accuracy of the data (for the period necessary to verify it);

- if processing is unlawful but the data subject opposes erasure and requests, instead, that its use be restricted;
- if the Data Controller no longer needs the data, but the data subject requires it for legal claims;
- if the data subject has objected to processing, pending verification of legitimate grounds.

Right to Erasure

In the cases specified in Article 17 GDPR, the data subject may request deletion of their personal data.

Legal Remedies

If the data subject considers that data processing does not comply with legal requirements, they may initiate proceedings with the **Hungarian National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (NAIH)** (Postal address: 1363 Budapest, Pf. 9.; email: ugyfelszolgalat@naih.hu), or seek judicial remedy.
